

Imagine raising a family of three school-aged children without access to an automobile.

Now imagine that the youngest child has come home from school today, full of excitement about an upcoming class field trip, and your family can't afford the required fee. Your 12-year-old has asthma and needs to see a specialist whose office is nowhere near your home. And your oldest is looking for a summer job and wants money — money you don't have right now — so they can get across town to apply for work.

This imaginary scenario is a daily reality for many low-income families across the United States. Issues involving access to transportation limit opportunities for low-income citizens across our own region, including access to work, health care, educational enrichment — even food.

Because transportation and opportunity are so closely linked, Greater Toledo Community Foundation has identified access to transportation as an important focus. Currently, three GTCF grant programs place special emphasis on expanding opportunities for children by increasing their access to transportation.

Youth Transportation

TARTA's Youth Summer Blast Pass: helping area youth make the most of their summers

In honor of our 50th anniversary in 2023, GTCF awarded \$50,000 each month to an area community organization as a part of our "50 Years of Funding Futures" campaign. One of these gifts supported opportunities for area youth through the TARTA Youth Summer Blast Pass program.

Typically, a reduced-fare 31-Day Pass from TARTA costs \$22.50 per month. The Blast Pass enables youth ages 6-19 to access TARTA services free of charge from June 1 through August 31. In 2023, with support from the GTCF grant and some additional funding from the City of Toledo, these summer passes were available at no cost to area families.

"The free Blast Pass was especially useful for opening opportunities to youth for summer employment," said TARTA Communication and

Marketing Manager, Andy Cole. "We didn't want finances to be a barrier for anyone — so the pass was good for not only bus service, but also TARTA Flex, which extends transportation services into many suburban areas outside established bus routes, and TARTA's paratransit service."

Noting that TARTA continued to promote the pass after the school year at various public locations and events, he added: "We spread the word at libraries, the summer Young Artists at Work program, Boys & Girls clubs and with similar groups to let them know that free transportation was available

Area schools were an important distribution point for Youth Summer Blast Pass applications. "Admissions, sports practices and other off-season rehearsals or training, and summer school are all school events that happen in the summer that the Youth Summer Blast Pass facilitated," said Cole.

for outings and group activities." The program eventually served 2,156 participants in 2023, and remaining GTCF funds will help TARTA to continue providing the fare-free summer passes for 2024.

Transportation Assistance Project (TAP): helping children envision their potential

The earliest of the three programs showcased here, the TAP initiative was driven by a 1990 community needs assessment that identified lack of transportation as a major barrier to youth participation in the region's many social, recreational and educational programs — including school field trips.

At the time of the report, the Toledo Public Schools system (TPS) did not pay field trip transportation costs. Instead, individual schools within TPS were responsible for this expense — and they still are. As a result, schools serving wealthier parts of the city can afford field trips while schools serving low-income areas could not.

To bring these enrichment opportunities to students from all backgrounds, GTCF created the Transport Assistance Project in 1991, with monies provided through the Stranahan Donor Directed Pooled Fund. Since then, TAP has granted nearly \$800,000 to various TPS and Central City Ministries schools, funding visits to educational destinations like the Toledo Museum of Art, Metroparks, Imagination Station and the Toledo Ballet for students in low-income neighborhoods.

"Without TAP grants, our children wouldn't have had these experiences," said Barbara Ferguson, principal of Toledo's Raymer Elementary School, and a former classroom teacher. Recalling an outing her classroom once had at a college biology lab, she noted, "Field trips like these give children an understanding of the world and of their potential."

Barbara also described how creative post-trip activities, like journaling or storytelling, helped young students develop their capacities for self-expression. "Parents with middle and upper incomes expose their children to broader experiences and the vocabulary to describe them," she said. "It all works together to develop a child's awareness and engagement. The TAP program makes it possible for children in lower-income families to enjoy these opportunities, too. For some students, a certain field trip might spark something inside of them. The experience could help them pursue similar opportunities, whether in a career or in education."

Mud Hens-Walleye Transportation Fund: sharing the joys of athletics ... and more

Youngsters from low-income backgrounds also may have limited access to the excitement and inspiration of live sports, a fact which helped drive the establishment of the Mud Hens - Walleye Transportation Fund. Since its inception in 2012, the fund has granted more than \$275,000, enabling kids from local schools and nonprofit organizations to enjoy our local baseball and hockey teams.

For some, the fund's benefit goes beyond a memorable day at the game. Brownstown Middle School band director, James Mobley describes how the fund has supported a pivotal opportunity for his students: traveling to Mud Hens and Walleye games to perform the National Anthem.

he 1990 report that began a focus on transportation for GTCF stated: "intervention in Pre-K and early childhood education can do more than alleviate current conditions: it can change the conditions of the region."

These initiatives are among the many ways the Foundation focuses on children's wellbeing to change the conditions of our region for the better.

"If we go on a field trip, it has to be educationally sound — so the best thing I can do for my students is allow them to perform and get feedback," said Mobley. "Students need the experience of performing outside their circle of comfort," he noted, recalling how the process of preparing for the event was as much of an educational opportunity as the performance itself. "When I tell the 6th graders that there will be about 6,000 people at the event, they go into a bit of shock — but the 7th graders have done it before and look forward to the experience."

It is also not uncommon for youngsters from low-income families to attend school in affluent communities, where they lack many things that their school friends take for granted. Mobley explained how the fund helps close this gap for such students.

"Our school is in a community of wide demographic backgrounds," he said. Many families are well off, but 30% of our kids are receiving free or reduced-cost lunches. The grant makes it possible for me to assist students who've told me that their parents can't afford to pay for the trip."

Two lifelong friends collaborate on end-of-life giving

"My family moved to Old Orchard when I was nine years old," said Jim, recalling the day he first became friends with Leonard — or "Len," as Jim calls him. "School was out and I didn't know anyone in the new neighborhood, so I went out for a bike ride. I saw Len and recognized him as the kid that always beat me at swim meets — so I stopped to talk with him."

That initial encounter led to a friendship so strong, Len would call the two of them "the dynamic duo" throughout their lives. Though the boys went on to play different sports (Jim, football; Len, swimming) and went on to different careers (Jim practiced law, Len owned and managed four cosmetology schools), they remained best buddies, enjoying area nightlife

when young and travel as they grew older, and occasionally reconnecting with high school buddies, until Len's passing from a second bout with cancer in 2022.

"Len had philanthropic gifts in mind before cancer struck him a second time," said Jim. "He owned and operated a number of cosmetology schools and wanted to use some of what he had accrued over the years to support two of his greatest loves in life: swimming and animals," he recalled fondly. "He wanted my help to create something special with the resources he would eventually leave behind."

Len was not just a swimmer — he was a champion, posting more than 500 career first-place finishes and ranking in the top 20 at a national YMCA meet during his teen years. Len's desire to share his love of swimming inspired Jim's recommendation to establish a legacy fund with Greater Toledo Community Foundation to support operations and swimming education at Toledo's city pools during summer months.

Noting Len's deep affection for his pets — a cat, two whippets and a greyhound — Jim also described how he helped his friend create another legacy fund on behalf of an uncommon animal beneficiary: police dogs. Len's gift will support the acquisition of four-legged police force members, and training for both the pups and their Toledo Police handlers.

Jim was especially pleased that the Toledo Police K-9 unit will honor Len with a special patch recognizing his gift on K-9 handlers' uniforms. "And one of their new pups has been named in his honor," he added proudly. "They've called him Lenny."

The Jim Appold Family

Family members honor their father by sharing his love of a game

When Jim Appold's family decided to establish a memorial fund in his honor, they knew it would have to involve his first love; baseball.

"We had been married almost 15 or 20 years before he shocked me by saying he always thought he'd be a professional baseball player," said Pat Appold, his high school sweetheart and wife of nearly 60 years. "He was athletic and played baseball as a youngster. He was also tall — so in high school, basketball was his sport. But he always loved the Detroit Tigers."

Eventually, Jim's exceptional talent for all things mechanical diverted him from sports and into engineering. Following college, he and Pat married and promptly started their family in their hometown of Saginaw. After five children, three master's degrees, various engineering jobs and a move to Toledo in 1975, Jim's career took a significant turn in the early '80s when he joined Consolidated Biscuit, a cookie factory in McComb, Ohio. As an employee and later as its owner, Jim built the three-oven factory into an enterprise of 10 facilities in seven states that employed nearly 4000 people.

"With all of this going on in Jim's life, baseball was a wonderful outlet for him," said Pat, recalling their many trips to Tiger Stadium and a shared suite at Comerica Park. Her gift to Jim of a two-week fantasy baseball camp was a special high point — Jim met famed Tigers announcer Ernie Harwell, played ball with former team members, and got to know several alumni of the 1968 World Series championship team. As planning began for a new ballpark to house the Tigers farm team here in Toledo, Jim was delighted to serve on the Mud Hens stadium advisory committee. "We had four field seats and a suite right away," said Pat.

Jim's death came in April 2020, a time when the COVID pandemic meant no public service could take place. As they considered a location for Jim's celebration of life two years later, his family saw Mud Hens stadium as a natural choice — and a youth sports program as the ideal recipient for one of two memorial gifts* in Jim's memory to Greater Toledo Community Foundation.

After consulting with the Mud Hens general manager, Joe Napoli, the Appold family honored Jim with a \$25,000 donation to the Let's Play Summer Tour Program. A partnership between the Mud Hens, the City of Toledo, Connecting Kids to Meals, Lucas Metropolitan Housing and GTCF,

"Let's Play" gave 151 area children an opportunity to learn either baseball or hockey fundamentals with adult coaches during six half-day sessions held from June to August 2023.

"Baseball was Jim's path to philanthropy," noted Pat. "He always believed in team sports for kids. He wanted to encourage that, but never force it — Jim wanted kids to be kids. Our family wanted kids from all over the city to be involved and have a happy experience that would develop their love of the game."

Establishing

The Foundation offers a variety of ways for you to make donations to reach your philanthropic goals. You can establish your own fund at the Foundation either during your lifetime or through your estate plan. All grants distributed from your fund — today and in the future — are awarded to charities, as determined by you, in the name of your fund.

Your gift to the Foundation may be made in many forms. Corporations and businesses are limited to gifts of cash, securities, closely-held stock, limited partnership interests and real estate. You and your family have even more options to consider.

Vehicles for giving

A cash gift is tax deductible as provided under current law.

Donations of appreciated **publicly-traded securities** are accepted. This type of gift avoids capital gains tax and allows the maximum tax deduction for the full market value of the gift. The Foundation also accepts **closely-held stock** and **limited partnership interests**.

Gifts of **cryptocurrency** are an accepted gift option. This type of gift allows the donor to avoid capital gains tax while still supporting your favorite charity. For tax purposes, cryptocurrency is designated as property and is subject to the same rules that apply to noncash charitable gifts.



4 Simple Steps to Create Your Fund

Define your charitable goals.

Decide if you want family members involved, both now and/or in the future. Consider how much involvement you want in selecting the charitable organizations that will receive grants from your fund. Think about how much you want to give in charitable contributions each year.

a Fund

A **bequest** in your will is a simple way to leave a lasting legacy.

A **life insurance policy** can be changed to designate the Foundation as the owner and/or beneficiary of a policy.

Retirement fund accounts are often your largest asset. You can give all or part of these assets to the Foundation, both during your lifetime and/or at your death.

Real estate (land, primary residences, vacation homes or farm land) can be donated to the Foundation and deducted at full fair market value, up to 30 percent of your adjusted gross income. The Foundation sells the real estate and the net proceeds capitalize a new fund or are added to an existing fund. Similarly, **tangible personal property** can be donated to the Foundation, which is also then sold.

A **charitable remainder trust** allows you (or other named beneficiaries) to receive lifetime income. Upon your death, the remaining principal creates a fund at the Foundation. You receive an immediate charitable deduction for a portion of the gift and avoid capital gains tax.

A **charitable lead trust** creates income for the Foundation for a specified period, after which the remaining principal is distributed to named beneficiaries. Gift and estate taxes are reduced with this type of gift.

Transfer of a private foundation affords you many advantages, including lower overhead, staff to assist with your charitable goals and a higher tax deduction for any future gift, to name only a few.

How involved do you want to be in your grantmaking? Do you want to give to a specific organization or a specific area of interest? Launch a scholarship to honor or memorialize a loved one? Restrict your giving to northwest Ohio and/or fund internationally? Create or continue your business giving program? Whatever your giving goals, there is a fund option for you.

The Foundation offers a number of fund options for you, your family, businesses and nonprofit organizations. A fund at the Foundation operates like a private foundation, but without the administrative and legal burdens associated with private foundations. The funds are flexible and you decide how much or how little you want to be involved in making grants.

Choosing a fund option

Community Fund respond to changing times

A community fund is the broadest option and leaves the decisions about your gift to the Foundation. You trust the Foundation's extensive experience and knowledge of the community to identify the most pressing needs and effective programs. A community fund provides maximum assurance a fund will remain timely and relevant. Grants from these funds are given to qualified organizations to support the well-being and vitality of our region and its residents.

Designated Fund support effective organizations

You support one or more specific charitable organizations or institutions in perpetuity.

A designated fund may help a single arts program, a food bank or a children's program during your life and after your death. If a beneficiary organization ceases to exist, loses its tax-exempt status or changes its mission, the Foundation redirects support to a similar organization to honor your original intent.

Donor Advised Fund engage with your giving

You take a more active role in your grantmaking (whether local, national or international). A donor advised fund provides maximum flexibility for your grantmaking, allowing designated advisors (named by you) to make recommendations regarding grants from your fund.

The Foundation facilitates compliance with financial, legal and tax requirements, as well as helps develop grantmaking strategies, articulates funding guidelines and conducts due diligence, relieving you of the administrative responsibilities associated with charitable giving. If you wish, the Foundation helps you identify additional organizations that you might consider supporting. You have several options.

- Individual advised fund Allows only you to make grant recommendations.
- Family advised fund Provides a simple and popular way for your family to engage in organized philanthropy.
- Corporate advised fund Offers flexible options for your business and/or employees' charitable giving programs. Your company or business can outsource all, or any part, of its charitable giving program to the Foundation for management.



You can endow your fund, requiring that the principal of the fund remains untouched and only a percentage of the annual earnings on the fund are available for grantmaking; or you can create a growth fund (non-endowed) allowing the flexibility to distribute both fund principal and annual earnings, although not below the minimum required fund balance of \$10,000.

Donor Directed Pooled Fund

direct your giving to specific organizations

This type of fund allows you the privilege, during your lifetime, to annually designate specific charitable organizations to receive grants from your fund.

Field of Interest Fund connect personal values to grantmaking

You direct funding to specific causes (the environment, youth programs or the arts, for instance) or geographical areas (a town, county or region) that you feel strongly about, yet it does not restrict grants to any one particular organization. A field of interest fund supports issues or areas that are important to you in perpetuity.

Organization Endowment Fund

sustain nonprofit organizations

The Foundation's years of experience with the nonprofit community enables us to assist other charitable organizations in managing their assets. By establishing an endowment fund at the Foundation, nonprofit organizations are relieved of the administrative burdens and costs associated with holding their own endowment fund, while receiving a steady stream of income for operations, programming or other organizational needs.

Scholarship Fund invest in education

You establish an educational scholarship for a specific interest. Scholarships can support any level of education, and may be directed toward students who are graduates of a particular grade or high school, students planning to attend a particular secondary or post-secondary school, students in a particular field or students from a certain geographical area.

Supporting Organization

partner with the Foundation for access to community information

A supporting organization is a separate and distinct legal and grantmaking entity that is in direct affiliation with the Foundation. It maintains its own board of trustees which has decision-making authority relevant to grant recipients and other matters. A supporting organization's alliance with the Foundation reduces administrative, investment and regulatory burdens. Family involvement, individual attention, flexibility, professional staffing and access to community information are among the key reasons that families and businesses create supporting organizations at Greater Toledo Community Foundation.



Individual advised fund - Allows only you to make grant recommendations.

Family advised fund • Provides a simple and popular way for your family to engage in organized philanthropy.

Corporate advised fund • Offers flexible options for your business and/or employees' charitable giving programs.

Your company or business can outsource all, or any part, of its charitable giving program to the Foundation for management.

You can endow your fund, requiring that the principal of the fund remains untouched and only a percentage of the annual earnings on the fund are available for grantmaking; or you can create a growth fund (non-endowed) allowing the flexibility to distribute both fund principal and annual earnings, although not below the minimum required fund balance of \$10,000.



GTCF's Commitment to Supporting Access for All

The Board of Trustees of Greater Toledo Community Foundation (GTCF) approved plans for an Equity & Access Initiative in 2020 to proactively address the concerns raised by communities that are disproportionately impacted by inequity and lack of access in the Greater Toledo area. The Foundation has committed grant funding toward this effort, and through 2023 awarded \$485,390 in grants through three rounds of funding to 19 nonprofit organizations over two years. The GTCF Board of Trustees voted to commit an additional \$100,000 in 2023 to local nonprofits from minority-led, smaller permanent staffed, novice and established nonprofits that incorporate a proactive grassroot approach to fund new and existing projects that align with the focus of the fund.




